Held on: 08th August 2020

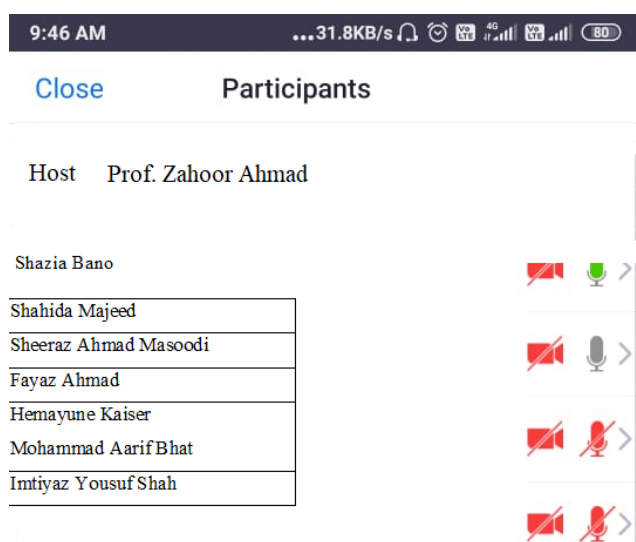

3. INTER-COLLEGE ONLINE QUIZ ON APPLIED ARABIC GRAMMAR

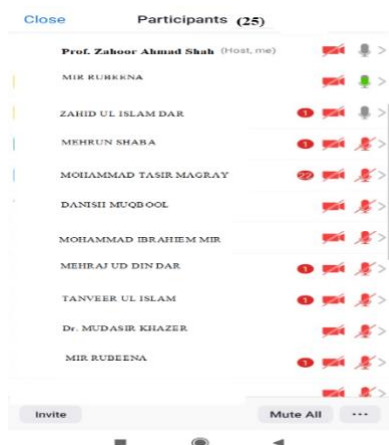
Held On: 30th September 2020

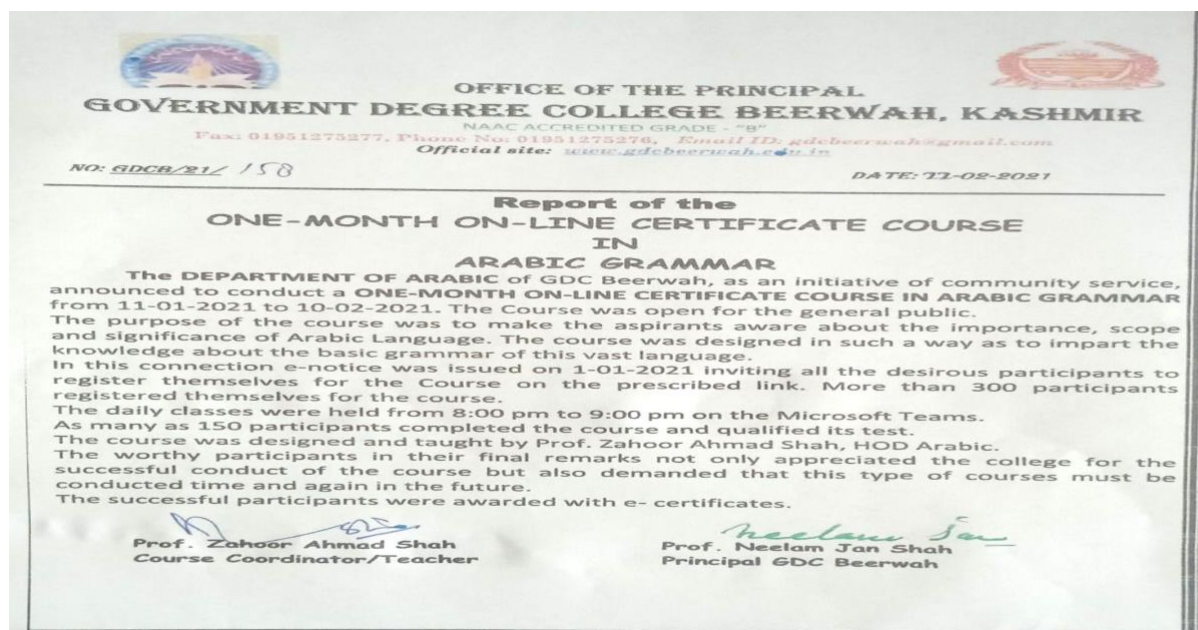

6. INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION CUM INAUGURATION OF TWO INDUSTRIAL SKILL COURSES IN GDC BEERWAH

Held on: 10th March 2021

Government Degree College Beerwah organized a workshop on International Women's Day 2020 on 10th of March 2021. The theme of the day is **Choose To Challenge – Forge a Gender Equal World and Take Action for Equality**. As part of the workshop the college also inaugurated two new Industrial Skill Courses on **Mobile Repairing and Self-Employed Tailoring**. Both courses are started to provide new career choices, especially to female students of the college. The training programs are run in collaboration with two Skill Sectors – Electronic, and Apparels of the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC).

The chief guest for the program was Prof. Shiekh Ajaz Bashir, Principal Islamia College of Science and Commerce/ Coordinator T&P Higher Education Department (HED), Kashmir Division. Prof. Ajaz highlighted on the role of HED in imparting skill-based training courses and placement in college of Kashmir. The Guest of Honour for the program was Prof. Zahida Naseem, Principal Govt. Degree College Budgam. Prof. Zahid spoke on the role of women in technology and emphasized on the benefits the introduction of new skill courses will give to female students of the college. Mr. Virender Dhiman, CEO Electronics Sector Skill Council of India highlighted the role of mobile technology and the avenues of employability for youth in the sector. Ms. Faiza Majeed, Project Manager Multichannel Educational Institute reflected on the self-employed tailoring as a job role, and avenues of employability for young women in the sector in Kashmir. The program was presided over by Prof. Neelam Jan shah, Principal GDC Beerwah who welcomed as well thanked all the guests, faculty and students for their presentations and inputs in the session.

The program was attended by around 50 students of the college who have been selected for training under these two industrial skill programs. These skill courses will be of 400 hours (around 6 months). In addition, to job role trainings, the courses will also provide soft skill training including CCC to the trainees.
