

### 1. Pending AQAR Submissions:

- The Principal took a serious note of the pending AQARs for the years 2021-22 and 2022-23.
- It was urged to urgently complete the data submission for these reports. The committee agreed to expedite the process to meet the required deadlines.

#### 2. Student Feedback:

- It was emphasized that feedback from students regarding the functioning of the college should be collected and compiled promptly.
- The IQAC members responsible for the component of Curricular Aspects were assigned to start the feedback process immediately.

#### 3. Admission Process for 2023-24:

- The admission committee was directed to closely monitor the admission process for the academic year 2023-24 to ensure a fair distribution of major courses among the students.
- o It was impressed that a major should not be assigned to less than 10 students to maintain the integrity and effectiveness of the courses.

### 4. Acknowledgment of National Conference:

- All college committees, particularly the Social Works Department, were congratulated for successfully organizing a two-day National Level Hybrid Mode Conference on "Social Protection for an Inclusive Development" on 22nd and 23rd June 2023.
- Departments, especially Science departments, were encouraged to organize similar conferences and workshops in the future.

#### 5. Framing of Academic Calendar:

 It was decided to frame an academic calendar to ensure the smooth functioning of the academic process. The committee agreed to draft the calendar and finalize it in the next meeting.

#### 6. Academic Monitoring:
