- 1. Review of Progress on Completion of Pending AQAR from 2021-22 Onwards:
 - The meeting commenced with a review of the progress on the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) from the year 2021-22 onwards.
 - In the previous meeting, seven components of each year's AQAR were distributed among various IQAC members for necessary data collection.
 - Each member provided an update on their progress, specifically for the 2021-22 year.
 - It was observed that approximately 70% of the work has been completed in each component.
 - Members were instructed to complete the remaining work in the upcoming week for timely submission to the NAAC portal.
- 2. Discussion and Review on the Progress and Steps Taken to Fulfill the NAAC Recommendations of Previous Cycle
 - The committee reviewed the progress and steps taken to address the recommendations provided by NAAC in the previous accreditation cycle.
 - Members discussed the implementation status of various initiatives and corrective actions recommended by NAAC.
 - The need for continuous monitoring and periodic review of these actions was emphasized to ensure compliance and improvement in quality standards.
- 3. Details about the New Binary Accreditation Framework
 - An informative session was conducted on the new Binary Accreditation Scheme, which has been implemented from 1st July 2024.
 - Members were briefed on the significant changes and new attributes of the Binary Accreditation Framework.
 - The college, Government Degree College Beerwah, is required to apply for Maturity-Based Grade Accreditation under this scheme starting from January 2025.
 - Detailed explanations were provided on the new matrices and attributes to ensure all members are well-informed and prepared for the upcoming accreditation process.
- 4. Completion of AQAR for 2023-24

- It was decided that the AQAR for the year 2023-24 would be completed in the upcoming week.
- The completion will be conducted in a round-table fashion to expedite the process and ensure a fast-track submission.
- 5. Proposed Changes in Committee Members:
 - Some members proposed changes in the assignment of components to different committee members.
 - These proposed changes were reviewed and incorporated as detailed in Annexure "A".

- 1. All members must complete the pending AQAR work for 2021-22 in the coming week for submission to the NAAC portal.

- 3. The IQAC members are to familiarize themselves with the new Binary Accreditation Framework and prepare for the Maturity-Based Grade Accreditation application starting January 2025.
- 4. The AQAR for 2023-24 is to be completed on a fast-track basis in the upcoming week.
- 5. The proposed changes in committee members' assignments, as detailed in Annexure "A", were approved and are to be implemented immediately.
